Preventive Health Program	Preventive Health Program (e- Clinics)	Bulandshahr District, Uttar Pradesh & Haridwar District, Uttarakhand & Sirmaur District, Himachal Pradesh	E-clinic services in rural areas have been very beneficial towards the health care in rural population. Through the use of technology, e-clinics have provided essential medical and healthcare services to remote communities that previously had limited access to medical care. The objective of e-Clinic services was to provide primary medical care to those who needed it the most in various rural communities across various states. These primary treatments have helped people to identify their symptoms, which may require further secondary or tertiary treatment. The goal of e-Clinic services is to improve primary healthcare access and reduce healthcare costs overall. A total of 18 e-Clinics are operational, 4 of which are located in Bulandshahr of Uttar Pradesh; 8 in Haridwar & 2 in Rudrapur of Uttarakhand; 1 in Sirmaur District of Himachal Pradesh; 2 in Salumber District of Rajasthan & 1 in Karnal District of Haryana. These clinics provide free medical consultations and generic medicines to villagers in the Districts. <b>Approximately, 25000 treatments were completed till 31st March 2024.</b>
	Health Camps	Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, and West Bengal, Rajasthan	SATYA Shakti Foundation organized 24 Health Camps Davangere, Chitradurga & Honnali; Thiruvavur, Thanjavur, Cuddalore; Kheda, Narmada, Bharuch, Dahod; Bhilwara; Hisar, Jind, Kaithal, Panipat, Karnal; Angul, Balangir; Midnapore, Kharagpur; Indore, Ujjain, Bioara, Itarsi of Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Haryana, Odisha, West Bengal & Madhya Pradesh, during FY 2024-25. The purpose of this initiative was to raise awareness about the importance of staying healthy and not ignore any potential symptoms that may require urgent medical attention. With these free health camps, health consultations, general counseling, and medical guidance from MBBS doctors on matters such as mother and childcare advices, diet and nutrition, and generic medicines were made available to all. The goal of this initiative was to provide accessible and quality healthcare services to those in need. <b>An approximate total of 4000 beneficiaries were treated through these free health camps.</b>

Welfare Activities	Fireoutbreak Relief camp	Villages - Jagiraha, Barahiharitola, Bhatawan, Madhopur, Badh-Hara Buzurg, Birawat Komwaliya of Bihar Villages - Hathuwan Basi, Pipar Tola and Padrauna of Uttar Pradesh	To provide relief to the affected people, Satya Shakti Foundation had organized a total of <b>9 fire relief camps</b> in Padrauna and Tamkuhi branch. The Satya Shakti Foundation team mainly focused on the affected villages. Houses were burnt to ashes due to the sudden fire in the villages. In this incident, five people were burnt alive, out of which two died. Many underwent treatment in the hospital. Many cattle also burnt to death. <b>About 450 people got support through this relief operation.</b>
	Dental & Painting Competition	Bulandshahr District, Uttar Pradesh	<b>Dental Awareness Program</b> among the Children in <b>2 schools of Dhanaura Village of Bulandshahr</b> covering a total of <b>150 students</b> . Dental Kits were also distributed to the children. The Doctor demonstrated the cleanliness habits to the children. <b>A painting competition</b> was also organized to encourage all the children and felicitate the winners. <b>Approx. 180 children participated during Children's day celebration</b>
	Teacher's Day celebration	Haridwar	SATYA Shakti Foundation celebrated the <b>Teacher's day</b> in one of the schools in the rural parts of Bulandshahr district with the Teachers and children especially in the project areas of the SATYA Shakti Foundation. During the <b>Teacher's Day competition about 30 children participated</b> in debate, singing and dancing competition. Also, <b>160 children</b> in the same school were given <b>goodie bags and snack packets</b> . The goal was to recognize and felicitate the Teachers who are helping shape the future of our country.
	Menstrual Hygiene	Bulandshahr & Haridwar	<b>Menstrual Hygiene Awareness and Program</b> in various villages of Bulandshahr and Haridwar, <b>covering about 1000 women</b> . Hygiene dignity kits were distributed. The women had an interaction session with the Doctor where the questioned the doctor regarding certian pratices and taboos and cleared their understand on the subject.
	Children's Day Celebration	Haridwar	<b>SATYA Shakti Foundation team celebrated Children's Day</b> with the children of Primary School, Village Chandpuri Khadar, District Haridwar of Uttarakhand state by conducting a painting competition. The Children were also given loving gifts like school bags, stationary kits, crayons, Note Books, packaged dry food kits, fruits and sweets. <b>A total of approximately 130 packets were distributed to the children.</b> The teachers were also presented with gift packs.
