Preventive Health Program	Preventive Health Program (e- Clinics)	Bulandshahr District in Uttar Pradesh ; Haridwar District in Uttarakhand ; Sirmaur District, Himachal Pradesh ; Salumber District in Rajasthan, Karnal District & Bijnor District in Haryana ;	E-clinic services in rural areas have been very beneficial towards the health care in rural population. Through the use of technology, e-clinics have provided essential medical and healthcare services to remote communities that previously had limited access to medical care. The objective of e-Clinic services was to provide primary medical care to those who needed it the most in various rural communities across various states. These primary treatments have helped people to identify their symptoms, which may require further secondary or tertiary treatment. The goal of e-Clinic services is to improve primary healthcare access and reduce healthcare costs overall. 20 e- Clinics were operational. 8 in Haridwar + 2 in Rudrapur + 4 in Bulandshahr + 1 in Sirmaur + 2 New e- Clinics in Salumber + 2 e- Clinics in Karnal + 1 e-Clinic in Bijnor. A total of approximately 26000 treatments were done by the end of FY 2025 -26
	Awareness on Menstrual Hygiene	Haridwar District, Uttarakhand	SATYA Shakti Foundation conducted a menstrual hygiene awareness program in Haridwar district wherein a total of 120 participants attended the program. These included school-going girls, community women, teachers, and health volunteers. The session saw active participation and interaction throughout. Hygiene dignity kits were also distributed.
	Eye Check - up Camp	Delhi NCR	An eye camp was organized to avail basic eye health services accessible to all, particularly for individuals who required regular medical check-ups. A total of approximately 200 individuals were benefitted with free reading glasses for the individuals. As part of the camp, free reading glasses were distributed to those identified with vision deficiencies. In addition, eye drops were given to individuals with complaints like irritation, redness, or dryness. Instructions for usage and follow-up care were also provided.
	Flood Relief Camps	Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir state	During the last rainy season, the rain fall was tremendous across the country especially in the northern states. SATYA Shakti Foundation took the initiative to distribute the dry ration to the affected areas of the states of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir. SATYA Shakti Foundation, with the unwavering support of SATYA MicroCapital Limited, organized Flood Relief Camps in the worst flood-affected villages of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir state. Places like Ferozpur, Sangrur, Dhuri, Rayya, and Batala in Punjab; Makwal, Thalwal, Top Mandal, Prahladpur, Belicharana, Kabir Colony, Vikram Chowk, Vivekanand Colony, Kot Jagir, Gujjar Nagar, Goswami Basti, Peerkho, and Mandal in Jammu & various places in Himachal Pradesh These villages & communities were severely impacted by the recent floods, leaving many families in distress. Through our relief camps, we provided essential supplies, food items, and necessary support to help the approximately affected 400 Families over all to overcome during this challenging time. We believe that with this effort, approximately 1600 individuals of the reached out families were covered in the flood affected areas.
